**5<sup>th</sup> Interim report of the Review Committee on review of Private Forest provisionally identified by North and South Goa Forest Division Committees (V.T. Thomas & F.X. Araujo Committee)**

A committee (hereinafter referred as Review Committee"), to review Provisionally identified Private Forest areas by North and South Goa Forest Division Committees (also known as Thomas & Araujo Committee) was constituted vide Government of Goa Notification No. (WP)/Pvt. For/16(THC)/ 2013(WZ)/19-20/26 dated 21/01/2020 (with Conservator of Forests as Chairman) and Vide Notification No. DCF (WP)/Pvt. Forest/16(THC)/ 2013(WZ)/19-20/119 dated 18/06/2020 (The Chief Conservator of Forests was made the Chairperson). First Interim Report of the Review Committee disposing 858 Survey Nos was submitted to the Govt. for approval vide DCF (Working Plan) office note dated 26.04.2021 which may be seen at **Annexure I**. For criteria and methodology 1<sup>st</sup> interim report may kindly be referred. Following the same criteria and methodology the Committee has undertaken further review work. Second Interim Report of the Review Committee disposing 1236 Survey Nos (cumulatively) was submitted to the Govt. for approval vide DCF (Working Plan) office note dated 01.07.2021 which may be seen at **Annexure II**. Third Interim Report of the Review Committee disposing 1306 Survey Nos (cumulatively) was submitted to the Govt. for approval vide DCF (Working Plan) office note dated 08/09/2021 which may be seen at **Annexure III**. Fourth Interim Report of the Review Committee disposing 1459 Survey Nos (cumulatively) was submitted to the Govt. for approval vide DCF (Working Plan) office note dated 06/01/2022 which may be seen at **Annexure IV**.

The Government of Goa has approved all the four interim reports submitted by the Review Committee thereby disposing a total 1459 survey numbers out of 3349 (3195 survey numbers identified by

Thomas and Araujo Committees plus 154 Survey numbers identified and excluded by Thomas and Araujo Committees) survey numbers provisionally identified by Thomas and Araujo Committees. Earlier, three interim reports were uploaded on the website of Goa Forest Department in compliance to the order of Hon'ble NGT on 13.09.2021. Subsequently, fourth interim report was uploaded on the Forest Department website on 23.02.2022 after obtaining Government approval and approval of Election Commission of India to upload it during the period of Model Code of Conduct of assembly Election.

An extensive ground verification, enumeration and survey exercise on survey numbers qualifying on area & canopy density criteria has been done in the field for evaluating species composition criteria. Additional staff from other Divisions have been deployed to territorial Divisions to enhance the manpower availability for speed up of the enumeration exercise in the field.

Despite various field constraints, the efforts have been taken up to complete the review work in a time bound manner and substantial progress has been made in the field. The status of progress achieved in enumeration of private forest areas as on date is shown as under:

Thus, it can be seen that roughly 98% of the total area to be enumerated (9183 Ha) has been enumerated. Balance area (around 200 Ha) for which strong public opposition is reported are to be verified, surveyed & demarcated on ground after consultation with the land owners or to be taken up through police protection, if consultation does not work.

Further, the Hon'ble NGT in EA 21/2021(PB) in OA 478/2018 filed by Goa Foundation in its order dated 27.01.2022 has ordered to file compliance report by 30.04.2022. Therefore, it was decided by the committee to submit the 5<sup>th</sup> Interim Report to the Government to put on record the progress achieved by the review committee as on date in reviewing the areas provisionally identified by Thomas and Araujo committees.

**A. Survey Numbers identified as Private Forest by Sawant and Karapurkar committees and found partly repeated in Thomas & Araujo Committees:**

There are a total of 130 such survey numbers across 39 villages were analysed partly/fully repeated and out of which 88 have been found fully repeated and accordingly status reported in the first Interim Report. Further, remaining 42 Survey Nos along with its 56 parts were reviewed by the Review Committee and the Review Committee, after detailed analysis through Google Timeline change corroborated by LISS III FCM 2012-13, Division offence case, Tree Felling, FCA & Court order etc. found that in 05 Survey Numbers balance area does not qualify the criteria of private forests and status reported in the second interim Report. In fourth interim report, the review committee reviewed the remaining 37 survey numbers and after detailed analysis through Google Timeline change corroborated by LISS III FCM 2012-13, Division offence case, Tree Felling, FCA & Court order etc. found that in Survey Number 52 village Penha de Franca of

Bardez taluka the balance area does not qualify the criteria of private forests.

Now, the review committee reviewed the remaining 36 survey numbers and after detailed analysis through Google Timeline change corroborated by LISS III FCM 2012-13, Division offence case, Tree Felling, FCA & Court order etc. found that in further 4 survey numbers the balance area do not fulfil the criteria of private forests. (**Annexure V**). Hence, the status of these Survey Numbers will be the same as decided by the previous review committee. Balance 32 survey numbers are still to be reviewed in the field.

**B. Survey Numbers identified as Private Forest by earlier demarcation team of the Forest Department (adjoining the Survey Nos. identified as Private Forest by Sawant and Karapurkar Committee) and found partly repeated in Thomas & Araujo Committee:**

In the first interim report, the Review Committee had found that out of total of 39 Survey numbers, adjoining Survey Nos of Sawant and Karapurkar Committee which were demarcated as Private Forests by earlier demarcation team of Forest Department during 2003-2008 were found fully/partly repeated in Survey Numbers identified by Thomas and Araujo Committee. In 1st interim report, two survey numbers were found fully repeated. In 2<sup>nd</sup> interim report, the committee had reviewed the remaining 37 survey numbers and after detailed analysis through Google Timeline change corroborated by LISS III FCM 2012-13, Division offence case, Tree Felling, FCA & Court order etc. found that in 17 Survey Numbers which are partly repeated, the balance area does not qualify the criteria for Private Forest and status reported in the second interim Report. Balance 20 survey numbers are still to be reviewed in the field.

**C. Survey Numbers recorded as Government Forests and found mention as Private Forest by Thomas and Araujo Committees:**

Further, there are a total 26 survey numbers of recorded Forest which have been identified as Private Forest by Thomas & Araujo Committee in its report. In the 1<sup>st</sup> interim report, it was decided to exclude survey numbers pertaining to Reserve Forest and to review Proposed Reserve Forest and Unclassified Forest under private ownership (*if any*) in the instant case for further analysis. 8 Survey Numbers were found fully under Government ownership. In the remaining 18 such survey numbers, no survey number could be excluded solely on area and canopy criteria. Now the review committee has verified the balance of 18 survey numbers and decided to exclude 06 survey numbers from review which are notified fully as Proposed Reserved Forests under Sec 4 of IFA, 1927. The decision of the committee on these Survey Numbers is enclosed as **Annexure VI**.

**E. Report based on Enumeration results of Survey numbers fulfilling area and canopy criteria.**

The field reports submitted by Sub-Committees were placed before the Review Committee. The Review Committee has reviewed the survey numbers qualifying as private Forests and conducted the hearing of objections/representations. In case of non-qualifying survey numbers based on enumeration results submitted by the Divisions/sub-committees, detailed analysis through Google Timeline change corroborated by LISS III FCM 2012-13, Division offence case, Tree Felling, FCA & Court order etc was done. The sub-committee report is enclosed as **Annexure VII**. The survey numbers not qualifying through enumeration were randomly checked by ACFs of Territorial Divisions and no discrepancy was reported. After detailed evaluation, deliberations and discussion on each report, the decision of the committee on these Survey Numbers is enclosed as **Annexure VIII**.

**F. Survey numbers which were provisionally identified and excluded by Thomas and Araujo Committee in its report.**

As decided in the 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the review committee, the committee has taken up review of all such survey numbers which were excluded from the list of provisionally identified survey numbers of private forest as per the methodology adopted by the committee. There were a total 154 provisional Survey Nos. identified by the Thomas and Araujo committee which were excluded in the final report. All those survey numbers were digitized and analyzed in detail.

In the fourth interim report, the review committee reported that 96 survey numbers are not qualifying the criteria to be identified as Private Forests as they were not meeting area & Canopy density criteria as per LISS IV Forest Cover Map 2014-15 (Forest Survey India) and based on the analysis of LISS IV Forest Cover Map 2014-15 (Forest Survey India, Google Timeline changes corroborated by LISS III Forest Cover Map 2012-13, North & South Goa Divisional history for offence cases, illegal felling, Tree Felling permissions, FCA & Court orders (if any) etc.

Regarding the review of balance 58 survey numbers (except those which are already obtained finally after acceptance of the report of the previous review committee under DCF (WP) by NGT) which are qualifying the area and canopy density criteria decision was taken to hold field verification for assessing the species composition criteria. Accordingly, a proposal seeking Govt approval for inviting representations/objections & contact details of the land owners through public notice and issue of addendum to the notification dated 18.09.2020 including three more villages for the purpose of ground verification has been sent to the Government (**Annexure IX**).

### **Summary of the Report**

- i) Till now, the review committee has prepared five interim reports disposing total 1630 survey numbers out of total 3349 (3195 survey numbers provisionally identified by Thomas and Araujo Committees plus 154 Survey numbers provisionally identified and excluded by

Thomas and Araujo Committees) provisionally identified by North Goa and South Goa Forest Division committees (also known as Thomas and Araujo Committees) and all the four interim reports have been uploaded on the website of Goa Forest department after Government seeking approval.

ii) In the fifth interim report, by disposing of an additional 171 Survey Nos, a total 1630 out of 3349 (3195 survey numbers identified by Thomas and Araujo Committees plus 154 Survey numbers identified and excluded by Thomas and Araujo Committees) Survey Nos has been completely disposed off. Proposal for inviting objections for starting field exercise to find out species composition in 58 survey numbers which were provisionally identified and excluded by the Thomas and Araujo committees in the final report and falling in the patches qualifying area and canopy density criteria has been submitted for State Government approval. As the area to be enumerated is less than 1 SqKm, it was expected that enumeration exercise for this area may be completed in 15 days.

Details of such survey numbers are submitted to the Government as indicated in the Annexures, summary of which is reproduced below.

iii) Out of an area around 9183 Ha corresponding to 3195 sy Nos which qualify canopy and area criteria, the ground verification, enumeration & survey of area of approximately 8984 hectares have been completed as on 15.03.2022. Thus, enumeration of around 98% area is complete. The ground verification in the balance area could not be completed due to strong public opposition in the field. Balance area (around 200 Ha) for which strong public opposition is reported are to be verified, surveyed & demarcated on ground after consultation with the land owners or to be taken up through police protection if consultation does not work; hearings to be held for affected persons (and 100% enumeration to be done in case of objector insisting for it) for which additional time is essential.


**iv) Detailed Status of Qualifying area is as follows:**

- a) Approximate qualifying area- Gross area 2879.12 Ha which includes 419.24 Ha of already finalized area by previous review committee chaired by DCF (Working Plan) thus giving a net additional area of approx 2459.88 Ha.
- b) 2459.88 Ha area included 953.466 Ha (excluding 419.24 Ha area in Sy. No.102 in Village Keri (Querim), Sattari Taluka is part of 41.2 SqKm area demarcated by Forest Department Demarcation team) area for which Divisions have reported that plan has been prepared and 1506.414 Ha is notional area based on qualifying points for which preparation of plans is in progress and exact area will be known on preparation of plan.
- c) Out of 953.466 Ha area for which it has been reported that plan has been completed by the Divisions, plans for 710 Ha have been received to the review committee/ DCF (Working Plan).
- d) Hearing for a qualified area of 710 Ha has been held till date after which 328 Ha has been finalized in all respect and reverification/100% enumeration ordered for the remaining 382 Ha after hearing of objectors.

Though enumeration through sampling of almost the entire qualifying area has been completed, additional time is required for preparation of


