

FINAL REPORT OF THE STATE LEVEL EXPERT COMMITTEE,
NORTH GOA DISTRICT.

Constitution of the committee:-

In pursuance of the directive contained in the order dated 16 December 2009, of Hon'ble High Court of Bombay at Goa, the Government of Goa is pleased to constitute following Committees vide notification No 7-1-2009/FOR/439 dtd.27/12/2012 for the purpose of identification of balance areas of Private Forests in the State of Goa.

The terms of reference and other conditions of the Committee:-

1. The Committee was to identify the balance areas of private forests in North Goa Division that have not been covered by the Sawant Committee Report and the Karapurkar Committee Report.
2. The Committee was to locate the private forests on ground individually, and judge them ocularly in conformation with crop composition (75% or more of the trees to be of forest nature) and canopy density (0.4 or more).
3. The DSLR/Revenue officer was to immediately estimate, through the land Surveyors, the geographical areas of such forests.
4. If such forests are found to be satisfying the three criteria (i.e. geographical area 5 Ha Or more if not contiguous to Government forests, crop composition of 75% or more trees of forest species and canopy density 0.4 or more) by the Committees, the DSLR and Revenue officers were to get

such identified private forests surveyed, plotted them on the map and incorporated them in the plans of the respective Survey Numbers.

For enabling this, the respective District Collectors, in coordination with the Director of Settlement and Land Records, was to depute a team of necessary and sufficient number of field surveyors to be at the disposal of the DSLR's officers in the Committees

5. The Committees was to demarcate such identified private forests from the non-forest area on the ground by pegs and on the maps as well
6. The Committees was to submit their monthly progress report to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, in the prescribed Format

As soon as private forests is finally identified (demarcated with pegs) in a particular survey number, the same were to be intimated by the Committees to DCF (Working plan) and upon receiving such intimation, the DCF (WP) was to immediately take steps to fix boundary stones around such private forests.


ACTION TAKEN BY THE COMMITTEE

1. Prospective areas were located by using Regional Plan 2021 with respect to already identified and demarcated private forests, natural cover and Govt. forests. Village maps along with google maps and were also used for locating potential private forests. Extensive field inspections were carried out to verify the field condition in respect of composition of existing tree cover, density and areas likely to exceed 5 ha. Such areas were brought under provisional list of private forest.
2. The Committee met on 134 occasions/days for field meetings/field inspections. The list of provisionally identified forest is enclosed as **Exhibit-I**.
3. Actual survey and demarcation by wooden pegs were taken up in the provisionally identified areas by a team of Surveyors from the Directorate of Settlement and Land Records since 2015.
4. Out of 1661.72 ha. (Approximately) of provisionally identified forests, an area of 326.51 ha was surveyed and demarcated. A list of which is enclosed as **Exhibit – II**. Before the final survey and demarcation, the concerned land owners were intimated and their objections/representations were evaluated with site inspections and genuine cases were considered for deletion and necessary changes were made in the final survey plan. List of such areas which were deleted is mentioned in **Exhibit – I**
5. These finalised survey plans were submitted to the DCF, North for taking up final demarcation in the field with permanent boundary marks. The final survey maps submitted for final demarcation is enclosed as **Exhibit – III**.
6. The committee also attended to many representations made by various NGOs and willing land owners for inclusion into private forest list. Such areas which were fulfilling the criteria of private forest, were also inspected and deserving cases were included to the provisionally identified list. A list of


such areas included into list of Private Forest is also mentioned in Exhibit – I.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMITTEE


- 1 The committee has provisionally identified an area of 1661.72 ha (approximately) area and out of which an area of 326.51 ha only could be surveyed during the tenure of this committee. Therefore, the exercise of survey should be continued and should be completed at the earliest.
2. On completion of the survey or during it, the actual demarcation of private forest area should be done with boundary stone.
- 3 Because of their unique ecological, bio-diverse endowments, endemism and aesthetic values, protection of these identified and demarcated private forest areas is of paramount importance. Therefore, adequate protection measures should be put in place by deputing sufficient protection staff.
4. Though the committee has taken utmost care in identifying the provisional private forest areas, there remains a remote chance of locating few more areas which may have inadvertently missed out by the committee.
5. The land owners should be compensated in lieu of income loss due to preservations of trees in their private land on perpetual basis. Adequate incentives to the land owners of these private forest in form of acknowledgements, rewards and long time economic benefits, as the government may deem fit, should invariably be provided for the ecological services rendered by keeping the Forest growth intact for all these years






