**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Range Forest Officer shall mark the trees before cutting.
2. Permission to fell the trees is granted at his/her own risk and without prejudice to the claims of the other person/s who may be having any right over the land of trees.
3. **The actual tree felling shall be carried out after 30 days from the date of issue of this tree felling permission. The tree felling may be completed within 45 days after completing 30 days as mentioned above. In case trees felling not completed within 45 days application for extension of time limit for felling of trees, shall be forwarded to this office through concern Range Forest Officer.**
4. Material produced from felled trees shall not be removed or disposed without permission of the Tree Officer.
5. He/She shall replant trees as per details given below during the ensuing/next planting season i.e. commencing from June, 2022 to Sept, 2022 in the property from where the trees will be felled.

6. To compensate the loss User Agency/Applicant is hereby advised to plant tall saplings with good endurance with minimum 8-10 feet height and 10cm diameter at 1 mtr. Height form ground level.
7. The event of failure on the part of permit holder to replant the trees as indicated above, the Trees Office shall take necessary action as per the Goa Preservation of Tree Act 1984.
