Photographs and signatures of the land owners/ representatives shall be invariably taken during the field verification and submitted along with the field verification report hereafter.

The Review Committee accordingly decided the following-

- 1. In view of objections raised by owners, it was decided that the concerned Sub Committee will revisit survey number 177 of Bethora Village Ponda Taluka to conduct verification in the presence of objectors/land owners and to submit its report along with the photographs of joint verification immediately, the review Committee has also decided to give additional sample points in some portion of survey number 177 of Bethora Village Ponda Taluka.
- 2. Review committee further observed that individuals representing family shall invariably bring no objection certificate from the family members, to avoid any legal complication.
