Objection from the villagers of Dharbandora Village of Dharbandora taluka were heard individually. The Member Secretary informed the Review Committee that the notice of hearing dated 21/03/2023 was served to each

objector through post, special messenger and also through telephone calls & messages.

The Member Secretary informed that public hearing scheduled for the day is being conducted for the areas qualifying as private forests based on three criteria of approved methodology. ie., Survey number qualified for area and canopy density criteria as per Forest Cover Map provided by Forest Survey of India were subjected to field enumeration by sub-Committee, on submission of plan and enumeration report by the sub-committee after which now it is placed before the Review Committee for public hearing on 05/04/2023.

The area qualified as private forest after field enumeration were verified in presence of the objectors. Field report along with copy of each such document / plan were shown to concerned objectors during hearing.

The Review Committee re-emphasized over the fact that the field verification is to be conducted in presence of the land owners or their representatives so as to avoid resurveys and unnecessary delays in disposing the cases.

The Subcommittees were directed to take all necessary actions to inform the objectors/owners of the lands/ representatives about the field verification and conduct the field verification in the presence of the land owners/representatives. Photographs and signatures of the land owners/representatives shall be invariably taken during the field verification and submitted along with the field verification report hereafter.

The Review Committee accordingly decided the following-

- Mr Victor Fernandes of survey number 72 of Dharbandora Village, Dharbandora Taluka was not present for hearing, the Review Committee decided to call him during next hearing.
- 2. In view of objections raised by owners, it was decided that the concerned Sub Committee will revisit survey number 94, 99,101, 104, 105, 108 of Dharbandora Village, Dharbandora Taluka to conduct verification in the presence of objectors/land owners on scheduled date and submit its report along with the photographs of joint verification immediately.
- 3. As the Sy No 106 Dharbandora Village, Dharbandora Taluka qualifies the criteria of private forest, the review committee decided to finalize the area as per plan identified by sub committee as Private forest.

4. Further during the review it was observed that there had been deterioration and development in the Sy No 106 of Dharbandora Village, Dharbandora Taluka from the year 2012 onwards the review committee desired to seek report from concerned DCF.

Copies of photographs and attendance sheet of the Public Hearing are enclosed as a part of the hearing proceedings.
