1. The Last date & Time of online application is 01/03/2021 upto 13.00 hrs.
2. The Last date of online submission of tender is 01/03/2021 upto 15.00 hrs.
3. The date & time of Technical Bid opening of online tender is 01/03/2021 upto 15.30 hrs and Financial Bid Opening is on 01/03/2021 upto 16.00hrs in the office of the Dy. Conservator of Forests, Wildlife & Eco- Tourism (North) Division, 1st lift, 4th floor, Junta House, Panaji- Goa.

The online application should accompany the following documents (Scan & Upload on the e-tender website):

1. Attested copy of Valid Registration certificate.
2. Attested copy of PAN card.
3. Attested copy of GST registration certificate and ARN copy.
4. Attested copy of Authorized Dealer Certificate
5. Mode of payment towards cost of the tender Document, EMD & tender Processing fee: to be paid online through e-payment Mode via NEFT/RTGS/OTC/debit card/credit card facility/net banking with pre-printed challans available on e- tendering website and directly credit the amount of ITG account as generated by challans for NEFT/RTGS/OTC.
6. The Applicant should upload the scanned copy of the declaration in prescribed format (Annexure-A) giving the names of the works in hand in the above mentioned category on stamp paper of Rs. 50/-.
7. The bidder must fulfill the following Technical Qualification & must submit a self attested copy of the documents as a proof for establishing their technical capability for evaluating the Technical bid:
 - i. Proof of being an OEM / Authorized Supplier / Dealer.

- iii. Brochures, GA Drawing, CE Certificate etc.
- iv. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
- v. Income Tax returns for the preceding 2 (two) years.
- vi. The details of supplies made for the similar goods in the Govt. / Autonomous bodies/Govt. undertaking during the preceding 2(two) years.
- vii. Technical specification on detail in Annexure 1.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRACTORS

1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
3. The bid document consisting of specifications, suppliers to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://goanivida.gov.in>
4. Those bidders not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
5. The intending bidder must have/obtain in a valid class III digital signature to submit the bid.
6. On opening date, the suppliers can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
7. Bidder must ensure to quote rate of each item.
8. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appeared that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0" & will be treated as incomplete tender & will be rejected outright. Also name of the bidder should be entered in respective cells.
9. The tenderer shall be responsible for the correctness and genuine of the documents uploaded during tender submission. Any discrepancies in the matter will be liable for rejection and suitable action.
10. No Hard Copies of the documents to be submitted in the tender box.
11. The Successful Bidder has to Supply the goods within 15 days from the date of receipt of supply order.
12. The Successful bidder must deposit 5% of the Value of the supply order as Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, may be drawn in the favour of Dy. Conservator of Forests Wildlife & Eco-tourism (N) and 5% Security Deposit Deducted from the Bill.
13. The Supplier should quote including GST all the charges Amount.
14. The bidders will not be permitted to alter or modify their bids after expiry of the deadline for receipt of bids.
15. All the information furnished along with the bid must be authenticated under the seal and signature of the bidder.
16. The successful bidder has to provide one year onsite warranty for both the engine and the Boat. The date of successful sea trial will be treated as start of warranty period. The bidder must submit a letter agreeing to the terms of warranty in its company's letter head along with the invoice
17. The supplier will have to do all Insurance as required under the relevant rules for the transportation of the goods and for delivering it at Chorao. The supplier should ensure that the goods are supplied in good conditions and in case of any damage whatsoever, the assessed cost shall be deducted from the final bill due for payment.
18. Sea trials will be conducted at Chorao in the presence of Technical Evaluation Committee constituted for the purpose. The cost of sea trials will be borne by the supplier/tenderer.
19. Taxes as applicable shall be deducted at source from the credit bills before releasing the payment to the successful bidder.
20. The undersigned reserves the right to reject the tender by assigning the reason thereof No claim, whatsoever, shall be allowed for the alleged loss/damage suffered to the bidders on account of such rejections.

21. The Deputy Conservator of Forests Wildlife & Eco-tourism (North) Division Panaji -Goa reserves the right to terminate the contract in the event of breach of the terms and condition of the contract by the contractor by assigning reason thereof by serving 15 days notice to the contractor. On such termination of the contract, the contractor shall not have any claim for compensation.
22. The Department reserves the right at the time of issuing a supply order to increase or decrease the quantity of boat originally specified in the tender without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions.
23. Disputes if any, emanating from the resultant contract may be addressed to the O/o of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests Altinho for settlement which shall be binding on both the parties.
24. The jurisdiction of the arbitration shall be in the court at Panaji -Goa.

Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected and right to reject any or all the tenders including the lowest without assigning any reason thereof is reserved.

Tenderer who does not deposit Cost of the Tender Documents, EMD & Tender Processing Fees against the work in the prescribed form shall be liable for rejection.
